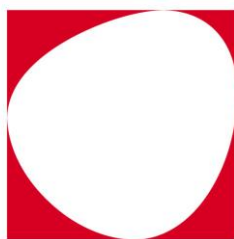


Japan Pavilion at Expo 2020 Dubai announces sixth wave of sponsors

■About Expo 2020 Dubai



Expo 2020 Dubai will be the first registered world expo held in a Middle Eastern or African country. Scheduled to take place over a 182-day period from October 1, 2021, to March 31, 2022, the event will herald the fiftieth anniversary of the founding of the host nation, the United Arab Emirates, and is expected to attract 25 million visitors. A total of 192 countries have declared their intention to set up exhibits on the 438-hectare venue grounds, responding to the expo's overarching theme of "Connecting Minds, Creating the Future" and its three subthemes: Mobility, Opportunity, and Sustainability.
